As children make their way back to school, it is important to remember you may be in a situation where you must report the abuse of a child. As an adult in the state of Texas you are a mandatory reporter. Something to live by is "If you see something, say something." Reports of child abuse can be made anonymously. It is not your job to determine if abuse is happening or not, but it is your responsibility to report suspicion.
