The CAC turned 4 years old this year! A lot has happened in those 4 years! We have gained employees, lost employees, moved buildings, and changed lives!

In 4 years, we have completed 756 Forensic Interviews, served 1,073 individuals, and completed 3,482 individual counseling hours.

We also partnered with Freedom House and Grace House to open a location in Springtown!
